On behalf of Safari Club International, I would like to thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Chapter 20, Wild Turkey Hunting Seasons.

The proposed changes to the Chapter 20, Wild Turkey Hunting Seasons generally demonstrates responsible and sustainable management of turkeys while maintaining high levels of opportunity for hunters. Specifically, SCI appreciates the simplification of turkey hunting units within the state from five units to one statewide unit and allowing additional options for evidence of sex instead of just one. Both changes will be beneficial to hunters in planning and conducting turkey hunts.

Further, SCI believes that sound science-based conservation involving hunting as the primary management tool, while maximizing opportunities for all huntable species, is necessary to the long-term health of wildlife. Hunters have long paid the way for conservation, both game and non-game wildlife, and maximizing opportunity for hunting is also key to long-term funding for all conservation.
