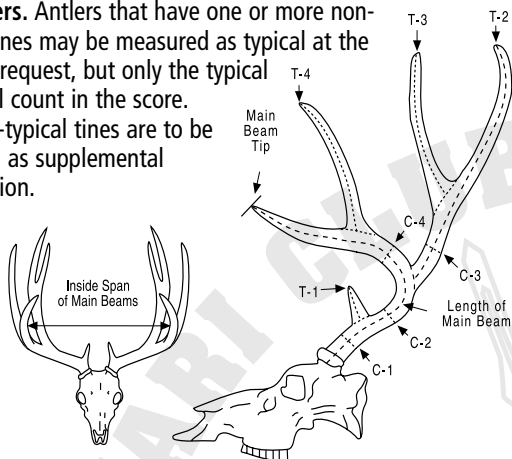

METHOD 18-T ENTRY FORM

For mule deer and black-tailed deer with typical antlers. Antlers that have one or more non-typical tines may be measured as typical at the owner's request, but only the typical tines will count in the score. Any non-typical tines are to be recorded as supplemental information.
